

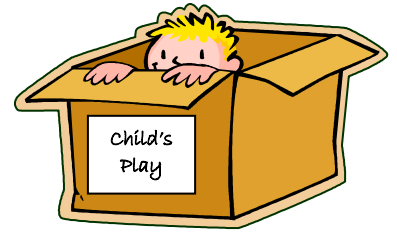

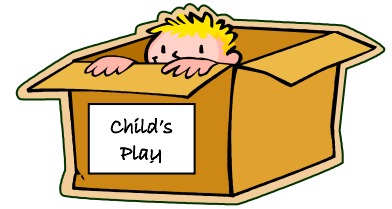
Join us to explore how to implement the Life Course perspective into our programs and services to support children and families with special health care needs in Indiana.
